Mute the Violence DC is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization committed to raising awareness about gun violence and fostering change within the Washington Metropolitan area. Our mission is to eliminate interpersonal violence by promoting understanding, creating alternative solutions, and building unity in underserved communities. We aim to empower individuals, particularly youth, to make safer decisions and improve their quality of life.

We serve black and brown communities disproportionately affected by systemic inequities, including lack of financial resources, education, and support systems. Our team addresses these challenges by providing critical resources, fostering meaningful relationships, and hosting events that give back to the community. What sets us apart is our resourcefulness and unwavering commitment to action—we transform challenges into impactful outcomes by ensuring every member of our team plays a vital role in driving change.

Mute the Violence DC offers a range of services to underserved youth aged 11 to 24 across all Wards in the Washington Metropolitan area. These services include Conflict Resolution and Mediation, Peer-to-Peer Mentorship, Big Brother Mentorship, one-on-one job preparedness training, and academic support. By equipping participants with the tools to navigate challenges, we work to improve community safety, foster personal growth, and reprogram negative behaviors into positive outcomes.

Our work is guided by a commitment to patience, love, consistency, and time. We strive to change mindsets, attitudes, and value systems by promoting independence, teaching positive life skills, and building resilience in individuals at risk or in crisis. Through these efforts, we aim to create safer, stronger communities where every individual has the opportunity to thrive.

Mute the Violence DC (MTVDC) is a nonprofit organization committed to reducing gun violence and empowering at-risk youth in the District of Columbia. Since beginning our mission in 2018 and officially founding in 2021, we have worked tirelessly to equip young people with the tools, resources, and support they need to make positive life choices and achieve their full potential. As part of the Community Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative (CVIPI), we are proud to report significant reductions in truancy, schoolbased violence, and suspensions, demonstrating the effectiveness of our programs.

- 2.Improve Emotional Intelligence: Build self-awareness, empathy, and emotional regulation.
- 3. Enhance Academic and Career Focus: Foster goal-setting and future planning for long-term success.
- 4. Promote Positive Peer Interactions: Cultivate healthy relationships and collaborative community culture.





Empowering Students, Families, and **Communities Through Comprehensive Programs**

We offer a wide range of workshops and programs aimed at empowering students, families, and communities. Our school and community workshops include Anti-Bullying Seminars, Cultural Awareness & Diversity Training, and Digital Safety & Cyberbullying Prevention, all designed to promote understanding, safety, and respect. Additionally, we provide Leadership Development opportunities through Student Leadership Training, Peer Mediation Programs, and the Youth Ambassadors Program to cultivate young leaders who can foster positive change in their schools and communities.

Our Career Readiness and Life Skills programs focus on preparing students for future success. We offer Career Exploration Sessions, Financial Literacy Workshops, and College Prep & Scholarship Guidance to help students explore career options and gain essential skills for their future. Health and Wellness programs, such as Mental Health Awareness Workshops, Physical Fitness & Self-Defense Classes, and Nutrition Education, encourage students to live healthy lives both mentally and physically.

We also offer Family and Community Engagement initiatives, including Parent Workshops, Family Counseling Sessions, and Community Forums. These services aim to strengthen family communication and build stronger connections between schools and communities. For specialized support, we provide Trauma-Informed Care Training, Anger Management Sessions, and Substance Abuse Awareness Programs. Our Youth Development and Enrichment services, like Summer Camps, After-School Programs, and the Arts for Change Program, foster personal growth and development outside of the classroom. Additionally, we support our community through Donation-Driven Initiatives, such as Scholarship Funds, Technology Access Programs, and Community Resource Drives to ensure equitable opportunities for all.


